Boccia is a Paralympic sport similar to the Italian game of 'bocce' for players of all ability levels. The game was designed for people with some loss of functional arm and hand movement, including people with cerebral palsy or acquired brain injury.



Sporting Wheelies and Disabled Association welcomes anyone to come along and try the game at any of our Boccia programs around the state. We offer two free trial sessions for anyone who has not previously attended a Boccia program.
